

Foreign participants are required to provide a medical certificate stating that there are no contraindications to the practice of competitive sports, competitive athletics or competitive foot racing, even if they hold a competition license issued by a federation affiliated to World Athletics.

Decree no. 2016-1157 of 24th August 2016 relating to the medical certificate attesting to the absence of contraindications to the practice of sport increases the validity of this document to 3 years **ONLY for the renewal of a sports licence**. For participation in a sports competition for non-licensees, a medical certificate **dated less than one year** before the day of the competition remains compulsory.
